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An Act relative to the right to cure provision in franchise agreements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 25E of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words, in line 14, “one hundred and
- 3 twenty” and inserting in place thereof the following:- “ninety”.
