An Act relative to neutrality in public contracts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 7 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition is hereby
2 amended by inserting the following new section:-

3 Section X. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, no awarding
4 authority shall require or prohibit bidders, contractors, or subcontractors to enter into or adhere to
5 agreements with one or more labor organizations, on the same or related projects, or discriminate
6 against bidders, contractors, subcontractors, or operators for becoming or refusing to become or
7 remain signatories or otherwise to adhere to agreements with one or more labor organizations, on
8 the same or other related public works projects.
