## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to the voting procedures for presidential electors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 53 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after "electors", in line 16, the following
3	sentence:- One presidential elector shall be chosen from each congressional district, and two
4	presidential electors shall be chosen at-large.
5	SECTION 2. Chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,
6	is hereby amended by striking out section 148, and inserting in place thereof the following
7	section:-
8	Section 148. The persons chosen as presidential electors shall meet at the state house on
9	the date fixed by federal law next following their election at three o'clock in the afternoon and
10	organize by the choice of a presiding officer and secretary. The state secretary shall call the
11	meeting to order, call the roll of electors, and preside until a presiding officer shall be chosen.
12	The secretary of the electors shall keep a journal of their proceedings and deposit the same in the

office of the state secretary, where it shall be recorded and filed. Each at-large presidential elector shall cast his ballot for the presidential and vice-presidential candidates whose electors received the highest number of votes in the state. Each congressional district presidential elector shall cast his ballot for the presidential and vice-presidential candidates whose electors received the highest number of votes in his congressional district.
