By Mr. Jones of North Reading, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1460) of Bradley H. Jones, Jr., and others for legislation to prohibit certain sex offenders from loitering within 500 feet of a school bus stop. The Judiciary.

The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to school bus stop safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after section 47, the following new section:
- 3 Section 47A. A sex offender who has been finally classified as a level 2 or level 3 sex
- 4 offender, and for as long as the sex offender is obligated to register, shall be prohibited from
- 5 loitering within 500 feet of a school bus stop which has been designated as such by any city,
- 6 town, or school district.
- For the purposes of this section, loitering shall mean remaining in the prohibited location
- 8 for more than 15 minutes. A sex offender who is the parent or legal guardian of a child scheduled
- 9 to depart from or arrive at a school bus stop, may remain at the prohibited location in excess of
- 10 15 minutes, but only until such time as the child has departed or arrived.
- 11 A sex offender who violates this section shall be punished by a fine of \$500 for a first
- offense; for a second offense by a fine of \$1,000, or by imprisonment in a house of correction for

- not more than 3 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment; and for a third or subsequent
- offense by a fine of 1,500 and not less than 3 months nor more than $2\frac{1}{2}$ years in a house of
- 15 correction. Written notification shall be made to the sex offender registry board of any such
- 16 violation.
