Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 62I the following section:-
- 3 Section 62J.
- 4 All buildings and developments that require an Environmental Impact Report and will
- 5 generate 1,000 or more daily trips or result in the construction of 300 or more new more parking
- 6 spaces shall be required to join and participate in the local Transportation Management
- 7 Association (TMA) if there is a TMA serving the municipality. Membership must be ongoing
- 8 and in good standing while the building or development is occupied.
