**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to monthly minimum reliability contributions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 139 of chapter 164 of the General Laws, as amended by section 9 of
2 chapter 75 of the acts of 2016, is hereby amended by striking the first sentence of the third
3 paragraph of subsection (j) and inserting in place thereof the following:-

4 The department shall exempt from any monthly minimum reliability contribution the
5 following: municipal ratepayers, low-income ratepayers, community solar ratepayers, and
6 owners of small-scale solar projects of 25 kilowatts or less.
