An Act relative to investments in tourism and visitation marketing and promotion.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 13T of chapter 23A of the General Laws, is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after the following subsection:-

3 (f) Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the fund shall not be  
4 subject to a charge for indirect costs or fringe benefit costs by the comptroller pursuant to section  
5 5D of chapter 29.
