An Act relative to the disabled veterans sales tax exemption on a motor vehicle.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 64H section 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 official edition, is hereby amended in line 350 by striking the word: “and” and inserting the word  
3 “or”
