Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1

2 Section 15 of chapter 84 as appearing in the 2016 General Laws is hereby amended by
3 striking in line 13 the word "five" and inserting in place thereof:-"one hundred".
