**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to the retirement benefits of certain employees of the Department of Public Health.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2010
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “prisoners;” in line 252 the
3 following words:-- employees of the department of public health within bargaining unit 8.
