Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “person”, in line 14, the
3 following words:- or by video conference.

4 SECTION 2. Section 65C½ of chapter 171 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is
5 hereby amended by inserting after the word “person”, in line 14, the following words:- or by
6 video conference.
