In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act to update Medicaid resource limits for seniors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1:	Section 25	of chapter	118E is hereby	amended by	inserting af	ter subsection

- 2 (5) the following two subsections:-
- 3 (6) the cash surrender value of any life insurance owned by the applicant or member or

4 his or her spouse without regard to the face value of the policy or policies;

- 5 (7) resources in the amount of \$2000 per individual and \$3000 per couple.
- 6 The division shall submit a state plan amendment to implement this section no later than
- 7 30 days after the effective date of this section and subsequently promulgate all regulations
- 8 necessary to implement said resource exemptions.
