An Act further regulating the withdrawal of local subscribers from commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (e) of section 19 of chapter 32B of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 208 the words  
3 “December 1”, and inserting in place thereof, the words:- March 1.

4           SECTION 2. Subsection (a) of section 23 of chapter 32B of the General Laws, as  
5 appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 46 the words  
6 “December 1”, and inserting in place thereof, the words:- March 1.
