An Act relative to local business owners voting in municipal elections.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 1F the following section:-

3 Section 1G. A city or town that accepts the provisions of this section may provide for the  
4 qualification and registration of voters for voting in any town meeting or municipal election to  
5 any citizen of the United States of the age of 18 years or more who, jointly or severally, is liable  
6 to the city or town for taxes assessed against such person on an assessment of not less than  
7 \$1,000 as of the last assessment of such city or town under section 11 of chapter 59.
