An Act relative to the retirement benefits of certain employees of the department of mental health.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 272, after the word "prisoners;" the
3 following words:-- employees of the department of mental health within bargaining unit 8;
