## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act to expand access to school meals.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 72 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official	Edition,

2 is hereby amended by inserting the following new section:

3 Section 72A: School districts shall qualify a student for free meal status if said child is a)

4 under the legal custody or guardianship of a grandparent or other non-parent relative, b) a child

5 with disabilities who receives Supplemental Security Income benefits pursuant to 42 U.S.C.

6 1382, or c) a child with special needs who was formerly in foster care and whose caregivers now

7 receive assistance under Title IV B or IVE guardianship or adoption assistance pursuant to 42

8 U.S.C.621.

9 The department of elementary and secondary education shall reimburse school districts 10 for costs incurred under this section . The department shall take reasonable steps to determine 11 whether such children qualify for direct certification of free school meals under 42 U.S.C. 1758

- 12 (b) (5), including children in receipt of MassHealth benefits in accordance with Chapter 118E of
- 13 the General Laws.
