The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act limiting the use of prison labor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 125 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

2 Section 22. No administrator or superintendent of any correctional institution, including
3 any correctional facility, county correctional facility, penal institution, state correctional facility,
4 state prison, or jail, shall transfer any inmate or prisoner outside of the commonwealth; and no
5 inmate or prisoner of any correctional institution, including any correctional facility, county
6 correctional facility, penal institution, state correctional facility, state prison, or jail, shall be
7 transferred outside of the commonwealth, for the purpose of engaging in labor outside of the
8 commonwealth.
