An Act relative to reciprocity of psychologists.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The board of registration of psychologists shall promulgate regulations relative to the
2 reciprocity of psychologists, which shall include the issuance of license, and the determination of
3 substantial equivalency, to be consistent with, but not in excess of the National Standards as set
4 forth by the American Psychological Association or the National Register of Health Service
5 Psychologists, and in compliance with Gubernatorial Executive Order number 562 § 3(3)
6 revoking and superseding Executive Order number 485.
