An Act relative to apportionment of lottery revenues.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 18C of chapter 58, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by striking out subsection (a) and inserting in place thereof the following  
3 subsection:-

4 (a) In this section, "budgeted aid" shall mean unrestricted aid to cities and towns  
5 payments in lieu of taxes from the commonwealth to cities and towns and education aid to cities  
6 and towns under chapter 70.

7 SECTION 2. Section 18C of chapter 58, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting  
8 after subsection (a) the following subsection:-

9 (b) State lottery revenue shall be apportioned to cities and towns proportionate to lottery  
10 sales in those cities and towns.
