Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Subsection (b) of section 17 of chapter 94G of the General Laws, as inserted by section
- 2 41 of chapter 55 of the acts of 2017, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the
- 3 following sentence:- Upon request of the commission, said departments and executive offices
- 4 shall: (i) provide the commission with any existing data so requested; and (ii) collect data as
- 5 requested by the commission to complete the research agenda required by this section and
- 6 provide such data to the commission.
