Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1: Section 52D of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 4, the words "by blood or marriage to
- 3 the employee, including a" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- by blood,
- 4 marriage, or adoption to the employee, including a parent or an adoptive.
