An Act relative to motor vehicle premiums.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The twelve paragraph of section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the sixth and seventh sentences
3 and inserting in place thereof the following 2 sentences:-The registrar shall develop a system for
4 separately reporting all non-moving violations. When the registrar has implemented the system,
5 all non-moving violations shall not be considered surchargeable incidents.
