In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to wage transparency.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 105D the
 following section:-
- 3 Section 105E. An employer shall provide the pay scale for a particular employment
- 4 position with said employer to an applicant for employment in such position or an employee
- 5 holding such position upon a reasonable request made by said applicant or employee. This
- 6 section shall apply only to employers that are covered employers under the federal Family and
- 7 Medical Leave Act of 1993, as amended, 29 U.S.C. 2601, et seq.
- 8 For purposes of this section, "pay scale" means a salary or hourly wage range for such 9 position, and "reasonable request" means a request made by an applicant for employment in such 10 position after the applicant has completed an initial interview with the employer, or a request 11 made by an employee regarding said employee's current position.
