An Act regarding the Cherry Valley and Rochdale Water District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Amend Chapter 105 of the Acts of 1996 by inserting the following: The following shall
2 have the right to vote at the Annual Meeting and any duly called Special District Meeting: (1)
3 any registered voter who resides within the boundary lines set forth in Section 2, (2) any
4 incorporated association or organization operating within the boundary lines set forth in Section
5 2 and which receives a bill from the District for water usage, (3) any person who owns property
6 within the boundary lines set forth in Section 2 and who receives the boundary lines set forth in
7 Section 2, and (4) any person or legal entity operating a business within the boundary lines set
8 forth in Section 2 and who receives a bill from the District for water usage, notwithstanding that
9 any such person or legal entity resides outside the boundary lines set forth in Section 2.

10 However, any registered voter who resides within the boundary lines set forth in Section
11 2, any incorporated association or organization operating within the boundary lines set forth in
12 Section 2 and which receives a bill from the District for water usage, any person who owns

13 property within the boundary lines set forth in Section 2 and who receives a bill from the District
14 for water usage, notwithstanding that any such person resides outside the boundary lines set forth
15 in Section 2, and any person or legal entity that conducts a business within the boundary lines set
16 forth in Section 2 and which receive a bill from the District for water usage, any person who
17 owns property within the boundary lines set forth in Section 2 and who receives a bill from the
18 District for water usage notwithstanding that any such person resides outside the boundary lines
19 set forth in Section 2, or person or legal entity operating a business within the boundary lines set
20 forth in Section 2 and who receives a bill from the District for water usage, notwithstanding that
21 any such person or legal entity resides outside the boundary lines set forth in Section 2 or take
22 any other action thereon.
