In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)

An Act relative to a Micro-Business stimulus package COVID-19 pandemic.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 This legislation will provide \$15,000 grant subsidy to micro-business owners across the
2 commonwealth who have under 5 employees and sales from 2018 taxes that did not generate
3 over \$200,000 in revenue.

4 75% of the grant must be used for direct payment to employees compensation and 25%
5 for small business general operational losses towards goods and services during the coronavirus
6 COVID-19 pandemic.
