In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to higher education capital investment in gateway cities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 258 of the acts of 2016 is hereby amended by inserting the

2 following section after section 14:-

Section 15. Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary, the authorizations
contained in this chapter may not be used to fund projects that fail to meet one of the following
criteria: (a) construction of the project began prior to July 1, 2019; (b) the project is not located
in a municipality that is or is adjacent to a gateway municipality, as defined by section 3A of
chapter 23A of the General Laws, or (c) the project is located within a gateway municipality, as

- 9 so defined, is within 2000 feet of such municipality's city hall and is or will be within 500 feet
- 10 of public transportation upon completion of the project.
