An Act clarifying the Prevailing Wage Law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 27D of Chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official ^[L]_[SEP] Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “works” in line 5, the
3 following words:- and the inspection, testing and repair of fire protection systems in public
4 building and public works.
