An Act relative to justice in the workplace.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of Chapter 151B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 182, the words “300 days” and
3 inserting in place thereof the following words:- “6 years”.
