**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to TNC driver suitability.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 159A1/2, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by by striking out in subsection (b) subclause (iv) the following words:- “(4)
3 felony robbery; or (5) felony fraud; and” and inserting in place thereof the following: “or (4)
4 felony robbery; and”

5 SECTION 2. Said section, as so appearing, is hereby further amended in subsection (b)
6 by adding the following new subclause at the end thereof:- (ix) A conviction for felony fraud
7 shall not result in a negative determination of suitability.

8 SECTION 3. Said section, as so appearing, is hereby further amended in subsection (b)
9 by adding the following new subclause at the end thereof:- (x) If the final disposition of an
10 offense was as a continuance without a finding, the offense shall not result in a negative
11 determination of suitability.
