**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to social consumption of marijuana.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (b) of section 3 of chapter 94G of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 25 of chapter 55 of the acts of 2017, is hereby amended by striking
3 out the word “The” the first time it appears and inserting in place thereof the following:-

4 “A city or town may, through an ordinance or by-law, allow the consumption of
5 marijuana or marijuana products on the premises where sold. If a city or town does not have an
6 ordinance or by-law under this subsection, the”
