An Act allowing increased data access in opiate overdose reports.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first sentence of the second paragraph of section 1 of chapter 55 of the  
2 Acts of 2015 is hereby amended by inserting after the word “protection” the following words:- “,  
3 the department of revenue”.

4 SECTION 2. The first sentence of the second paragraph of section 1 of chapter 55 of the  
5 Acts of 2015 is hereby amended by inserting after the words “information database” the  
6 following words:- “; income data”.
