### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act to reduce atmospheric pollution.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 31c of chapter 111 as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting after the third paragraph the following paragraph:-
- Reasonable rules and regulations adopted pursuant to this section may include imposition
- 4 of a local surcharge on commercial parking spaces and/or a cap on the number of such spaces
- 5 available in any city or town, or portion thereof. The board of health or other legal authority
- 6 shall consider and take account of any other limitations on parking established pursuant to other
- 7 legal authority in said city or town. Furthermore, said board of health or other legal authority
- 8 may also vary the rate of surcharge based on the number of commercial spaces dedicated to zero
- 9 emission vehicles. All funds derived from such surcharges shall be paid directly to the city or
- 10 town to be used solely for the purposes of air pollution abatement and improvements in
- 11 transportation infrastructure.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
