**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court  
(2019-2020)**  
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An Act providing consumers with equal protection for all real estate appraisals.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subdivision A of Section 174 of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence  
3 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- Except to the extent permitted under  
4 subdivision B, a person who has not obtained a real estate appraisal license or certification under  
5 this chapter shall not prepare, for a fee or other consideration, an appraisal or appraisal report  
6 relating to real estate or real property in the Commonwealth.

7           SECTION 2. Said Section 174 of said Chapter 112, as so appearing, is hereby further  
8 amended by striking out subdivision C.
