**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to dental hygienists.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 51 of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended in the final sentence of the second paragraph by inserting after “local
- 3 anesthesia agents,” the following words:-
- 4 “and nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia.”
