Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 requirement of such parole, and inserting in place thereof the following words:- may be required

- 5 SECTION 2. Said section is hereby further amended by striking out in line 6, the words,
- 6 "at all times for" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- "for all or any portion of".
- 7 SECTION 3. Said section is hereby further amended by striking line 7, the word shall,
- 8 and inserting in place thereof the following word:- "may".
- 9 SECTION 4. Section 47 of Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting in line 4 after the word "shall", the following
- 11 words:- "if ordered by the court".

- "at all times for", and inserting in place thereof the following words:- "for all or any portion of".
