**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act to ensure timely firearms license processing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 131 of Chapter 140 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition is hereby amended in subsection (e) in the third paragraph by inserting the
3 following at the end thereof:-

4 "If the licensing authority fails to either approve the application and issue the license or
5 deny the application and notify the applicant with the reason for such denial within 40 days of
6 the receipt of the application, the application fee shall be forfeit and the applicant shall be
7 entitled to a full refund of any fees paid for the processing of said application."
