## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to neglecting police stops.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 25 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line four, the words "or who shall refuse
- 3 or neglect to stop when signaled by any police officer who is in uniform or who displays his
- 4 badge conspicuously on the outside of his outer coat or garment,"
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 90 of the General Laws is further amended by adding, after section
- 6 25, the following new section:
- 7 Section 25A. Any person, while operating or in charge of a motor vehicle who shall
- 8 refuse or neglect to stop when signaled by any police officer who is in uniform or who displays
- 9 his badge conspicuously on the outside of his outer coat or garment shall have his license or right
- 10 to operate motor vehicles in the commonwealth suspended for a period of at least 180 days.
