An Act relative to elevator certification fees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 65 of Chapter 143 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following sentence:-

3           Should the owner or operator of the elevator contract another entity for the purpose of  
4 maintaining the quality of the elevator, all fines due to expired certification shall be assessed to  
5 the contracted entity.
