The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to collectively bargained health & welfare plans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, or any collective bargaining
2	agreement to the contrary, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts/NAGE Health and Welfare
3	Trust Fund and the NAGE, SEIU Local 5000/Trial Court of Massachusetts Health and Welfare
4	Trust Fund, may by a fifty percent vote of their respective trustees or other governing bodies
5	reimburse on a monthly basis those employees who are covered by a collective bargaining
6	agreement, but who are not members of the union that negotiated the agreement, a sum equal to
7	that sent to the Trust Funds by the employer on their behalf. Said reimbursed employee shall not
8	be eligible for any of the programs offered by the above Trusts.
