An Act establishing retirement parity for long term public defenders.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "attorneys", in line 328, the  
3 following words:-

4           , attorneys, investigators, social workers and social service advocates who have been  
5 employed by the Committee for Public Counsel Services for 10 years or more.
