An Act to protect non-medicare retirees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 32A or 32B of the General Laws, for retired public
2 employees over the age of sixty-five and not eligible for the federal Medicare program the
3 maximum amount of deductibles and copayments paid for covered services of group health
4 insurance provided in chapter 32A or 32B during an enrollment year shall not exceed \$2,500 for
5 individual coverage and \$5,000 for family coverage.
