An Act relative to retirement benefits for care givers at the Soldiers' Homes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1: Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official  
2           edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the phrase "duties assigned to them" in line 248 the  
3           following:- "employees of Holyoke and Chelsea Soldiers' Homes employed as Registered  
4           Nurses, licensed Practical Nurses, Certified Nursing Assistants, Recreational Therapist and  
5           physical therapy assistants;"
