*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (47/8E) of Section 20 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “board”,  
3 the fourth time it appears, the following words:- in which he receives said remuneration,  
4 financial benefit or consideration of any kind;
