### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to one day alcoholic beverage licenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 14 of Chapter 138 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following after the first sentence:-
- No person, firm, corporation, association, or other combination of persons, directly or
- 4 indirectly, or through any agent, employee, stockholder, officer or other person or any subsidiary
- 5 whatsoever, shall be granted, in the aggregate, more than 14 such licenses in the commonwealth
- 6 in a calendar year, or participate in decisions regarding such licenses or receive any percentage
- 7 or fee derived from gross revenues in exchange for management assistance, or participate in any
- 8 other action designed to effect common results of more than 14 license under this section in a
- 9 calendar year.
