**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to senior citizen property taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause Eighteenth of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 474, the word
3 “and” and inserting in place thereof the following word:- or

4 SECTION 2. Clause Eighteenth A of said section 5 of said chapter 59 of the General
5 Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after the words “the property or” in line
6 556, the following text:- one year after

7 SECTION 3. Clause Forty-first A of said section 5 of said chapter 59 of the General
8 Laws, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by inserting, in line 1197, after the words “the
9 property or” the following words:- one year after
