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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court  
(2019-2020)  
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An Act relative to adjusting the senior circuit breaker property valuation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Paragraph (3) of subsection (k) of said section 6 of chapter 62 of the  
2   General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the  
3   numbers “\$600,000” and inserting in place thereof the following:- or the average value of a  
4   single family home in the municipality as determined by the local Assessor for the previous  
5   fiscal year, whichever is greater
