*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official edition, is hereby amended in paragraph twenty-second by striking the figure "400" and
- 3 replacing it with the following figure: "1000"
