An Act authorizing the town of Raynham to suspend the collection of boat excise.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Section 2 of Chapter 60B of the General Laws or any  
2 other general or special law to the contrary, the town of Raynham may suspend the collection of  
3 boat excise until such time as the cost of collecting boat excise assessments is exceeded by the  
4 annual warrant amount that would be committed by the Board of Assessors to the Collector of  
5 Taxes in said town.

6           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
