**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act supporting voluntary income tax assistance sites.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or regulation to the contrary
2 and subject to appropriation, the department of revenue shall operate a program to support
3 organizations providing tax assistance services to individuals and families qualifying for the
4 Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program, in partnership with the Internal Revenue Service, for
5 the provision of said services.
