An Act relative to the Garden of Peace.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 35FFF of chapter 10, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the words “maintain the Garden of Peace” the following
3 words:- The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund and shall receive, deposit and invest all
4 monies transmitted to him under this section in accordance with sections 34, 34A and 38 of
5 chapter 29 in such manner as to secure the highest rate of return available consistent with the
6 safety of the fund, and shall credit interest and earnings on the trust fund corpus to the trust fund.
7 The state treasurer shall transfer funds from the income and receipts of the fund to the victim and
8 witness assistance board, as established in section 4 of 258B, from time to time, at the request of
9 the board.
